COSTA RICA

Licentiate Warner Céspedes Arias is an attorney at law. He started his whole national canine career as an exhibitor of the german shepherd breed, when he accomplished excellent results in his country of origin (Costa Rica) as well as abroad. Therefore, he obtained the second place in the 1998's Dog of the Year Award. Later on, he acquires an english pointer, which let him obtain the Dog of the Year Award in 1999. He was also able to accomplish important titles in different countries, such as the México World Show in 1999 and 2007, as well as the Mexican Championship for his english pointer and english setter dogs.

In the pursuit of letting the national and centralamerican canine activity grow, he intended to develop the breeding of english pointer and setter dogs, for which he managed to get excellent titles, e.g. championships in Costa Rica, Guatemala, México, SICALAM, America and the Caribbean and other international competitions.

Later on, he initiates the raising of australian terrier, papillon, fox terrier wire hair, pug and pekinese dogs. With the papillon, pekinese and australian terrier ones, he accomplished champion awards in México, America and the Caribbean and World Shows (México World Dog Show 2007). Therefore, it is notorious that his dogs have often reached excellent positions at their exhibitions. Moreover, his dogs have won their own groups during the Dog of the Year Competition.

During the Assembly for the FCI America and the Caribbean Section, he represented Costa Rica as a delegate. Likewise, he was also designated by the board of directors of the Asociación Canófila Costarricense (A.C.C.) as the delegate at the SICALAM 2006 Assembly, where he participated within the Arbitrage and Conflicts Committee of SICALAM. He represented Costa Rica at the FCI Assembly in Acapulco, México in 2007.

He has been elected for several positions in the Board of Directors of the Asociación Canófila Costarricense, i.e. secretary and president 2006-2007. In 2007 he was reelected for that same charge. He directed the Committee for the Engross of the Candidate for Judges and Judges Regulation in Costa Rica. He also directed the Committee for the Asociación Canófila Costarricense Ethics Regulation and the project to reform the exhibition rules of the A.C.C.

He has also worked as Exhibition Director at several national and international events held by the A.C.C. Furthermore, he served as judging secretary at different competitions organized by the Asociación Canófila Costarricense. He is a member of the Organizing Committee for the F.C.I. Judges Seminar, to be held in Costa Rica in 2009.

As a costarican judge, he has had an excellent performance both in national and international exhibitions, which include Costa Rica, Honduras, El Salvador, Chile, Ecuador, Mexico, Brazil and EE.UU.
